Visa regulations depend on your nationality and country of origin. We suggest you contact your local Mexican Embassy for official instructions on the specific visa regulations and application procedures that may apply to you. It is the responsibility of the participant to obtain a visa if required. When entering Mexico, all non-Mexican visitors must complete the Multiple Digital Migration Form (FMMd). Each individual can do so by accessing [the online form](#) (only available in Spanish) or via a paper form provided by airlines during your flight.

**Non-Mexicans also qualify for a 16% VAT exemption at hotels by presenting a copy of their immigration form upon check-in. Without this form, the exemption is forfeited.**

Please note, Mexican residents are subject to a 16% VAT at hotels, payable at check-in. Your safety and well-being are paramount to us, and we are committed to providing you with all the necessary information to make your trip to WCP24 both memorable and secure. All event activities (including educational sessions, meal functions, exhibit hall, etc.) are exclusively reserved for registered attendees. Non-registered guests (including children, family members, colleagues, etc.) are not allowed in any of the event areas. Badges provided at registration are required for entrance into all functions and will be strictly enforced. Please do not leave bags or suitcases unattended at any time, whether inside or outside the session halls. Hotels strongly recommend that you use their safety deposit boxes for your valuables.
